## How to access:

- 2) On the homepage click the Library & Knowledge Hub button to start your search

Previously known as Discovery Search

Search for journal articles, e-books and print books **all in one place.**

**Access the full-text of articles and e-books** (where available) or submit an online request.

**Avoid the less-reliable** sources that a general web search may find.

## Login for full-text access

Use your TSDFT login details for full-text access to journal articles and e-books (where available).

## Type your search term(s) into the search box and click the search button

You can enter keywords to run a general topic search or search for a specific book, journal or article title.

## Search options

By default, your search will return results which contain all of your search terms. Choose 'Advanced Search' or 'PICO Search' in order to access more search options.

# Results Page

Search for and browse specific journal titles.

View your search history.

Results are automatically sorted by relevance. Click to sort by date instead.

**Available limits:**

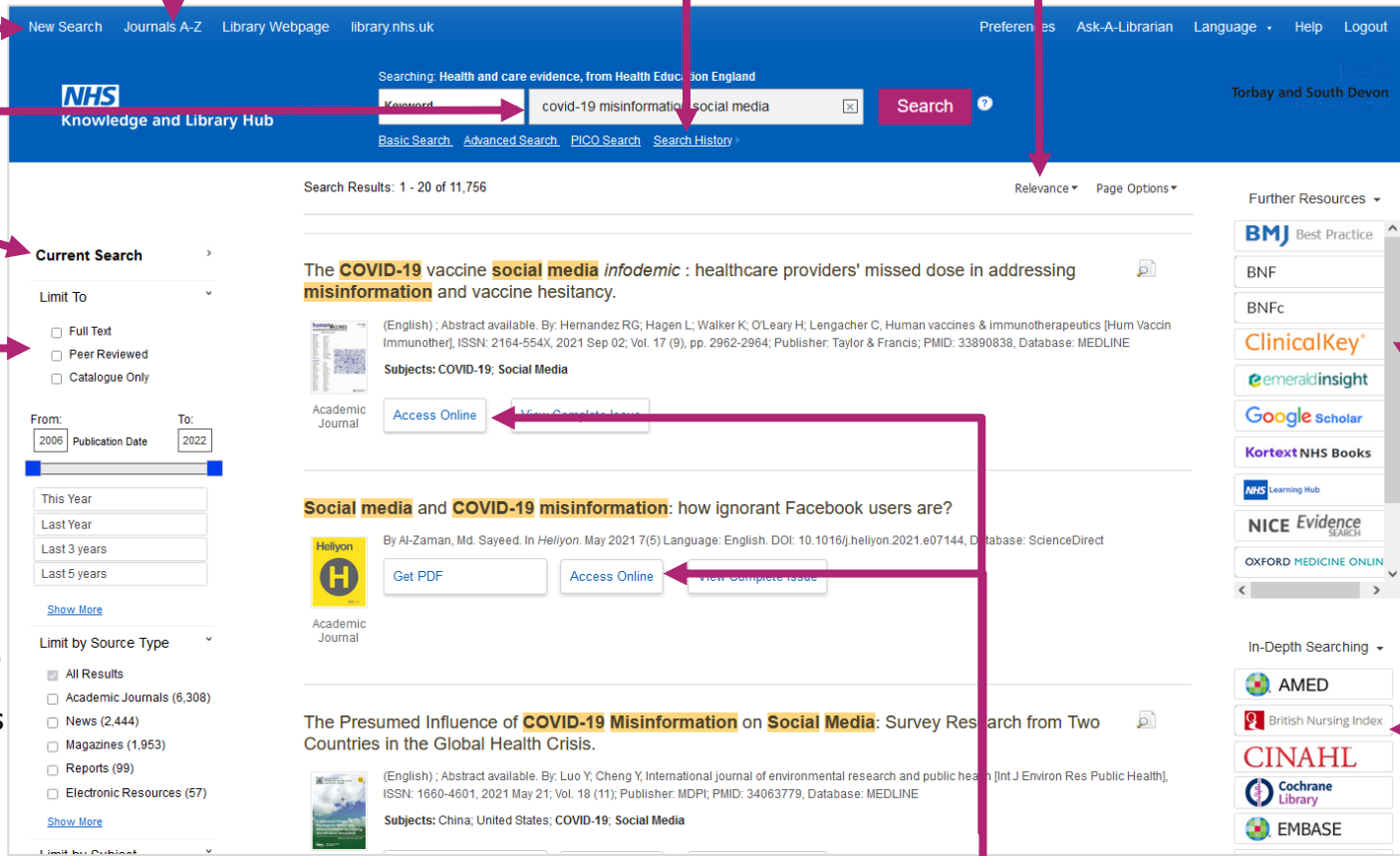
**Full text** = only results available to access online display.

**Peer reviewed** = only results that have been through a peer review process will be displayed.

**Catalogue only** = limits results to print books and other items held in the SWIMS catalogue

**Date range** = use the sliding scale to view items published between your chosen date range. Alternatively pick one of the defined date range buttons.

**Source types** = specify what type of resource you're looking for e.g. books, ebooks, journals (you may need to select show more to view all options).

Links to other databases for more in-depth and advanced searches.

**Online books and articles:** Will display either an 'Get PDF' / 'Access Online' / 'Full Text' or 'Request' button.

Results with an access online, get PDF or full text button are available to access online in full. Simply click the button and login with your TSDFT login details when requested.

Results with a request button are not available to access online but can be requested. To request simply click the button, enter your contact details on the request form and click submit.

**Print books:** The results list may also contain print book records. If the book is held at this library you will be able to see where it is shelved and if it is available to loan. If the book is not available a request button will display. To request simply click the button, fill out the required details and submit the request form.
